THE QUALITY POINTS AND ATTEMPTS FOR EACH COURSE ARE DETERMINED BY THE CHART AND DEFINITION BELOW. WHEN CALCULATING THE UNWEIGHTED GPA USE THE 4.0 QUALITY POINT SCALE (NO COURSES RECEIVE EXTRA WEIGHT). WHEN CALCULATING THE WEIGHTED GPA USE THE 4.0 QUALITY POINT SCALE OR THE APPROPRIATE WEIGHTED SCALE FOR WEIGHTED COURSES.

IF A COURSE HAS BEEN RE-TAKEN IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE FORGIVENESS POLICY, THEN ONLY THE HIGHER GRADE WILL BE USED IN THE GPA CALCULATION.

AFTER THE QUALITY POINTS AND ATTEMPTS ARE ASSIGNED FOR EACH COURSE AND ACCUMULATED FOR ALL COMPLETED COURSES, THE TOTAL QUALITY POINTS ARE DIVIDED BY THE TOTAL ATTEMPTS (CARRIED TO 4 DECIMAL PLACES) TO CALCULATE THE CUMULATIVE TO DATE GPA'S
