Students who do not meet these criteria will not be permitted to leave campus until they have shown improvement in the identified area(s). Note: Students, who accumulate an excessive number of absences and/or tardies after lunch or GPA goes below 2.5, are subject to lose their lunch and/or driving privileges!

Present your receipt and preliminary schedule to the photographer. SHS students are required to carry their I.D. card at all times. This card identifies you as a Seabreeze High School student. A current 2011-12 school ID is also required for the following: checkout textbooks, eat lunch in the café, access the Internet, acquire parking decals, voting, off-campus lunch (freshmen are not allowed off campus during lunch), student discounts, and for extra-curricular events on or off campus. Replacement ID cards are \$5.00.

Senior & Juniors Only
The following items are required to register for a parking decal: Parking Registration form signed by your parent; 2011-12 Student ID; Driver's License; and Proof of Insurance on the vehicle you will be driving to school. Due to the limited number of spaces available, a minimum cumulative 2.5 GPA is required; have no excessive absences, tardies, discipline referrals, or textbook & media obligations. Parking for seniors and juniors will be in the North and South lots.

Textbooks will be issued during orientation. You must have a current 2011-12 Student ID & preliminary schedule to check out textbooks.

Section 1. Paragraph (b) of subsection (3) of section 1006.28, Florida Statutes, is amended to read: 1006.28 Duties of district school board, district school superintendent; and school principal regarding K-12 instructional materials.—

(3) SCHOOL PRINCIPAL.—The school principal has the following duties for the management and care of instructional materials at the school:

(b) Money collected for lost or damaged books; enforcement.—The school principal shall collect from each student or the student's parent the purchase price of any instructional material the student has lost, destroyed, or unnecessarily damaged and to report and transmit the money collected to the district school superintendent. The failure to collect such sum upon reasonable effort by the school principal may result in the suspension of the student from participation in extracurricular activities or satisfaction of the debt by the student through community service activities at the school site as determined by the school.

VISITOR POLICY

PARENT PICK-UP AND DROP OFF

In an effort to make the campus a safer more secure place for all, access to the North student parking lot will be limited to students with current parking permits and will not be utilized for dropping off/picking up students. Parents are to utilize the loop in front of the school to drop off and pick up students. For safety and to minimize usage parents are encouraged to pull as far forward into the loop as possible.

WANT TO DRIVE???

The Florida Legislature has enacted requirements that schools report to the Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles (DHSMV) the names of those students who fail to satisfy the attendance requirements. Specifically, this refers to those students who accumulate 15 unexcused absences (excluding out-of-school suspension) within 90 calendar days or who have withdrawn from school under one of the state designated dropout codes.

The legislation further provides that those students who FAIL to satisfy attendance requirements will be INELIGIBLE for driving privileges.

PAY OBLIGATIONS

Students with obligations will not be allowed to purchase a parking decal (seniors/juniors only) or have the privilege of leaving campus for lunch (seniors/juniors/sophomores – freshmen are not permitted off campus for lunch). In addition, you must meet other criteria as stated in the Orientation Newsletter. To find out if you owe an obligation, go to www.seabreezehigh.org and click on the Obligation "link". Obligations are listed in ALPHA Code order. If you have an "X" "B" "F" in a column, you owe an obligation. For more information on your obligation contact the following departments:

ATTENDANCE

Regular school attendance is critical to a child's success in school. We know that parents share our dream of helping children to be the best that they can be. If we work together, this dream can and will become a reality. The Florida Legislature find that "poor academic performance is associated with nonattendance and that schools must take an active role in enforcing attendance as a means of improving the performance of many students." (F.S. 103.26)

Florida State Law says that:

- All children between the ages of 6 & 18 must attend school regularly. Students may withdraw at age 16 with parents permission.
- Parents are legally responsible for their children's attendance.
- If a child accumulates a minimum of 15 unexcused absences within 90 days, it is a violation of the Compulsory School Attendance Law (please note that law also requires a doctor's note is required after 15 absences.)
- After 5 unexcused absences within a calendar month or 10 unexcused absences within 90 days, the school's Student Success Team may review the attendance to determine if early patterns of truancy are developing.
- If the Student Success Team determines that a pattern of truancy is developing, a meeting with the parents must be scheduled to identify potential remedies.
- If parents refuse to participate in the strategies recommended by the Student Success Team, because they believe the strategies are unnecessary or inappropriate, they may appeal to the District School Board. If the District School Board's final determination is that the strategies of the Student Success Team are appropriate, the parents are expected to cooperate.
- In the event of the truancy continues and the parents remain uncooperative, the District School Superintendent may seek legal action against the parents.

Please call by noon on the day of the student's all day absence and as early in the day as possible if the student needs to check out early.

PARENTS NOTE: NO OUTPASSES WILL BE GIVEN FOR OFF-CAMPUS LUNCH. NO EXCEPTIONS.

When calling please have:

- Child's name
- Alpha Code
- Reason for the absence
- Name of person calling

This will ensure accurate attendance reporting and alleviate problems with make-up work.

WRITING CHECKS TO SCHOOLS

Your check is welcome at Volusia County Schools. The District recognizes that occasionally a parent may inadvertently overdraw a checking account and a check may be returned by the bank. In order to recover these funds in a private and professional manner, Volusia County Schools has contracted with CHECKredi, a company specializing in the collection of returned checks.

Each check written to the school must be made out to Seabreeze High School with the maker's name pre-printed on the check (no starter checks) and must include the maker's physical address and phone number (including area code). Please use blue or black ink.

When a person writes a check to a school or the District, the person writing the check agrees that, if the check is returned, it may be re-presented electronically on the same account for the full face amount and a fee established by Florida law.

CHECKredi will contact you by mail and by telephone in order to make arrangements to pay before attempting to re-present the check electronically. Payments of the check and fee may also be made online at www.checkredi.com using a credit card, debit card or electronic check without any additional fees. For a convenience fee, payments may be made over the telephone at (877) 524-7334 by credit card, debit card, or electronic check. Payments cannot be made at the school or the District.

DISTRICT DRESS CODE ADOPTED

The School Board of Volusia County recently adopted a district-wide dress code. Beginning with the 2011-12 school year, the dress code applies to every student in a Volusia County public school. The dress code establishes minimal guidelines for the appearance and dress of students. Basic requirements follow; however, the complete guidelines can be found in Policy 217:

- **HEAD** - No caps, visors, hoods, bandanas, sunglasses or other head gear, except with administrative permission.
- **UPPER GARMENTS** - All garments must cover shoulder to shoulder. All garments must be long enough to clearly overlap the beltline or stay tucked. NO halter tops, tanks tops, spaghetti straps or muscle shirts.
- **LOWER GARMENTS** - Undergarments and the buttocks MUST remain entirely covered even while seated. Dresses, skirts and shorts must be at least mid-thigh or below in length.
- **FOOTWEAR** - Shoes must be safe and appropriate. No slippers or shoes with wheels are permitted on campus. Cleats may be worn for appropriate extracurricular sports in proper areas.
- **ACCESSORIES** - Clothing, jewelry and accessories must not convey inappropriate messages.
