All seniors must register on line for the Bright Futures Scholarship – if you don't register on your own at home, listen for the announcements, you'll have some days during break to do it here at school with Mr. Richardson. If you need to still to take the ACT/SAT either for Bright Futures or College acceptance there are still two dates to take each.

Military – if you have joined or are planning to – tell us in Student Service – for Senior Awards night

We want to recognize all seniors who have enlisted in the military at our senior award program in May – you must notify us if you've enlisted – it's the only way we will find out!

Senior Awards Night – any awards/scholarships from colleges etc please notify us – so we can recognize you at Senior Awards.

Athletic Scholarships – come tell us Now!

We want to recognize all of our students who have earned some sort of scholarship at our senior award program. We will only know about if the seniors tell us – scholarships from the college they are attending, either academic or athletic, from local/national organizations, men's/women's clubs etc. – you must tell us about it – we won't know otherwise and you won't be recognized at the program. We realize you may not find out about some of these till later in the year – as you find please let us know.

NCAA Clearinghouse – must reg for DI/II-w/wo\$

Any student who participates in college at a Division I or Division II college must register with the NCAA Clearinghouse – whether you are receiving an athletic scholarship or are paying your own way and are a walk on to the team - this organization determines athletic eligibility for your freshman year. Questions can be addressed to the guidance office.

College Applications- haven't done it yet? SOON!

Mid- year reports – must let us know if needed

Application deadlines for many 4-year colleges have already past but some are coming up soon – if you are still planning on applying to 4-year colleges you must do it soon! Seniors also must notify the SHS registrar if the college you have applied to requires a mid-year report to be sent from your high school.

DSC – on site registration and CPT – APRIL –sign up in Student Services

Any seniors planning on attending Daytona State College next summer or fall can sign up in the guidance office for on-site registration here at Seabreeze in April – DSC admissions people will be here to administer the CPT and to register our seniors for DSC.

Volunteer Hours – turn in now!

Seniors – please turn in your forms for any volunteer hours as you get them – we don't want them all turned in the last month of the year.

Final Transcript – form later – must tell us soon! Strict Deadline – don't want to miss anyone being recognized-Will use this form for final college, major, Military, awards etc. Don't Wait!

Later in the spring, we need each senior to tell us what college to send their final transcript to – in other words what college will they be attending first after graduation. There is a form that each senior must fill out and turn in to guidance giving us this information – the forms will be available after spring break.
